

## Player Registrations U6 – U16

The WJFC Committee will determine the cut off date for registrations. All registrations received up to and including this date will be accepted in principal, but always subject to there being a vacancy in the relevant team and age group. Registrations received after this date are at the discretion of the Committee.

In the event there are more players registered than vacancies in the relevant team squad then the following applies:

- Preference will be given to those players who played for WJFC the preceding season
- Previous association with the club, player/parent, will be given due consideration
- Where possible the club will look to move players between age groups to achieve a balance and give each boy a chance to participate and play
- If there are more players registered than vacancies in the relevant team, then it is the WJFC committee that makes the decision on which players will fill the relevant team

The size of team squads for each age group is as set out below (consistent with SANFL Juniors Policy for 2017)

- Under 6 Under 7 teams: We will register up to 20 players in each team
- Under 8 teams: We will register up to 12 players in each team
- Under 9 Under 10 teams: We will register up to 16 players in each team.
- Under 11–Under 14: We will register up to 24 players in each team
- Under 15: We will register up to 28 players in each team

It is club policy that players play in their age group (refer to policy on playing under age players)

When there are 2 teams playing in the same age group from U12 - U15 there will be a team in the Red and White division, that is, an "A" and a "B" team. The selection process will be determined by the Football Sub Committee in conjunction with the relevant coaches.

It is WJFC Policy that registration fees must be paid at the time of registration by credit card payment. A registration will not be accepted until the full registration fee is paid. A play will not be permitted to participate in club training sessions or games (including trial games) until their registration is complete and fees are fully paid. This is to ensure that a player is covered by the club's insurance policies.
