

Selection of A & B teams U11 and above only

When there are 2 teams playing in the same age group from U11 - U16 there will be a team in the Red division and White division, that is, an "A" and a "B" team. The selection process will be determined by the Committee in conjunction with the coaches.

The following steps will be taken in determining whether a player is placed into the Red team or White team:

- A trial process will be conducted over a minimum of 3 weeks. This process may involve trial matches against other clubs but this is not mandatory
- The Football Subcommittee (FSC) will allocate a member of the Committee to attend the training sessions for a specific age group to monitor the training and selection process. This Committee member does not participate in the decision making process but may provide feedback to coaches on the process and be used as a sounding board for coaches. The Committee member should not have a child in the group to ensure independence.
- The Coach/Coaches for the trial process will submit a recommendation for the Red and White team to the FSC. The FSC will advise if they have any concerns with the proposed selections.
- Once the FSC has reviewed and advised that it is comfortable with the proposed selections the Coach will advise the parents

Coaches should be mindful that children and parents may be sensitive to their team selection or have a preference for selection in a team. It is important that the child's welfare and self-esteem are managed and positive communication is encouraged.

This policy mirrors SANFL policy that where a club "has registered two teams for competition, the general split will be one team in the red division and one team in the white division."

SANFL Rules, currently allow for some movement between groups in early rounds however it is not WJFC policy to allow this once selection has been finalised.
