

Team Selections for Finals

SANFL rules state: To qualify to play any finals game a player must have played **6 games** for their registered team in the minor round for that season. This rule is strictly adhered to by the SANFL.

The association allows squad sizes of 24 players and allows 22 to participate in all games including finals, 18 on the field and 4 on the bench.

It is the policy of the WJFC that for all finals games, boys may be chosen on merit. Merit may be interpreted as skill level, attitude, attendance etc. Where a team has more than 22 eligible players (24 in under 11) the players selected to play finals will be at the discretion of the coach and team manager.

Where a team has less than 22 eligible players, the Coach may request that the club seek permits from SANFL for players the same age group in lower divisions or from lower age groups.

In all cases finals selection must adhere to the relevant SANFL Juniors Policy at that time.
