

Player Milestones and Representation

Walkerville Junior Football Club (WJFC) promotes the recognition players that achieve milestones or are selected in representative squads.

Milestone games are considered 50 games, 100 games, 150 games and so on (although with under 6 to under 15 age groups achieving 200 or more games is unlikely).

The following guidelines will be used to determine the number of games played:

- All club games will be included
- Games played for another junior club can be included subject to appropriate evidence or validation of the number of games played
- State or other representative games will not be included
- Games played for schools will not be included

At the start of each year the Team Manager for each team will prepare a list of games played for each player and this will be used to enable coaching staff and parents to be aware of an upcoming milestone game.

Parents/guardians are encouraged to arrange appropriate recognition at the milestone game with a banner or similar. It should be noted that this is a parent/guardian responsibility and the club does not provide any assistance with this.

At the end of the season as part of the trophy presentation the club will provide recognition as follows:

- For players achieving 50 games a certificate
- For players achieving 100, 150 or 200 games a trophy or similar and club merchandise deemed appropriate by the Committee.

Where a Walkerville player is selected in a representative squad (eg State, Association etc) the club will provide some recognition of this achievement.
